Swiss Post's Christmas set depicts scenes just before nightfall

A Christmas stamp from Switzerland reproduces Martin Magli's photograph of Kandersteg Church, located in an alpine valley.

This 100-centime (1-franc) stamp is one of four issued Nov. 15 by Swiss Post.

The 85c denomination depicts the 13th-century Bottmingen water castle. Magli entered this photograph in a stamp-design contest and won. He then provided three other photographs for Swiss Post to use for the designs of its Christmas stamps.

In addition to the aforementioned 85c and 100c stamps, the Christmas set includes a 1.50fr stamp showing Bedretto, a village at the foot of the Nufenen Pass in Ticino; and a 2fr stamp picturing the 18th-century stone bridge in St. Ursanne, a medieval town in northwestern Switzerland.

Swiss Post describes all four designs as depicting buildings "in a winter wonderland, photographed in the 'blue hour,' shortly before nightfall."

Cartor Security Printing printed the stamps by offset in sheets of 20.



Bahamas stamps pay homage to beloved Christmas carol

Four Christmas stamps, with different denominations, from the Bahamas show churches, the moon and lyrics from Silent Night.

Four Christmas stamps issued Nov. 29 by the Bahamas include lyrics from the Christmas carol Silent Night. Each stamp includes two or three words from the first two lines of the carol.

For example, the 15ϕ stamp is inscribed "Silent Night" in the lower right corner. The design depicts the islands' oldest Baptist church, Bethel Baptist, founded in 1790. The original wooden structure has been rebuilt and renovated many times since.

The lyrics continue with "Holy Night" on the 25¢ stamp showing St. Agnes Anglican Church in Grants Town, and "All Is Calm" on the 50¢ featuring the Church of God Cathedral in Nassau. The



latter stamp shows the church under a half moon, while the moon is full in the other three designs. The 65ϕ stamp with "All Is Bright" and a view of the Hillview Seventh-day Adventist Church completes the set of four.

The stamps were designed by the firm Bee Design. Lowe-Martin printed them by lithography in sheets of 20.

Austrian stamp honors first Silent Night performance, 200 years ago

Austria commemorated the 200th anniversary of the Christmas carol Silent Night on this Christmas stamp depicting the Silent Night Memorial Chapel in Oberndorf

Austria issued a stamp Nov. 23 celebrating Christmas and commemorating the 200th anniversary of Silent Night. The design depicts the Silent Night Memorial Chapel in Oberndorf on a starry, snow-covered evening.

The small chapel stands on the spot where on Christmas Eve in 1818 Silent Night was first performed. Two Austrians wrote the carol: lyrics by Joseph Mohr (1792-1848) and music by Franz Xaver Gruber (1787-1863).

The song remains one of the most popular Christmas carols around the world.

According to the Austrian National Tourist Office, "Today, Silent Night is known in over 300 languages and dialects, and its reputation as an international peace message has been cemented by its inclusion within UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage list ... "

Anna Rastl designed this 0.90 stamp. Joh. Enschede of the Netherlands printed it by offset in sheets of 50.
